The founder of Netscape, Marc Andreessen, said in a 2011 column in the Wall Street Journal that “software is eating the world.” As he explained, Amazon, the world’s largest bookstore, is actually a software company and the fastest growing firms like Netflix, Pixar, PayPal and so on are all essentially software companies as well.

Six years later, Jensen Huang, founder of Nvidia, wrote in the MIT Technology Review that “AI is eating software.” He predicted that a new programming paradigm called deep learning would replace the traditional performance and development methodology of software and revolutionize most industries.



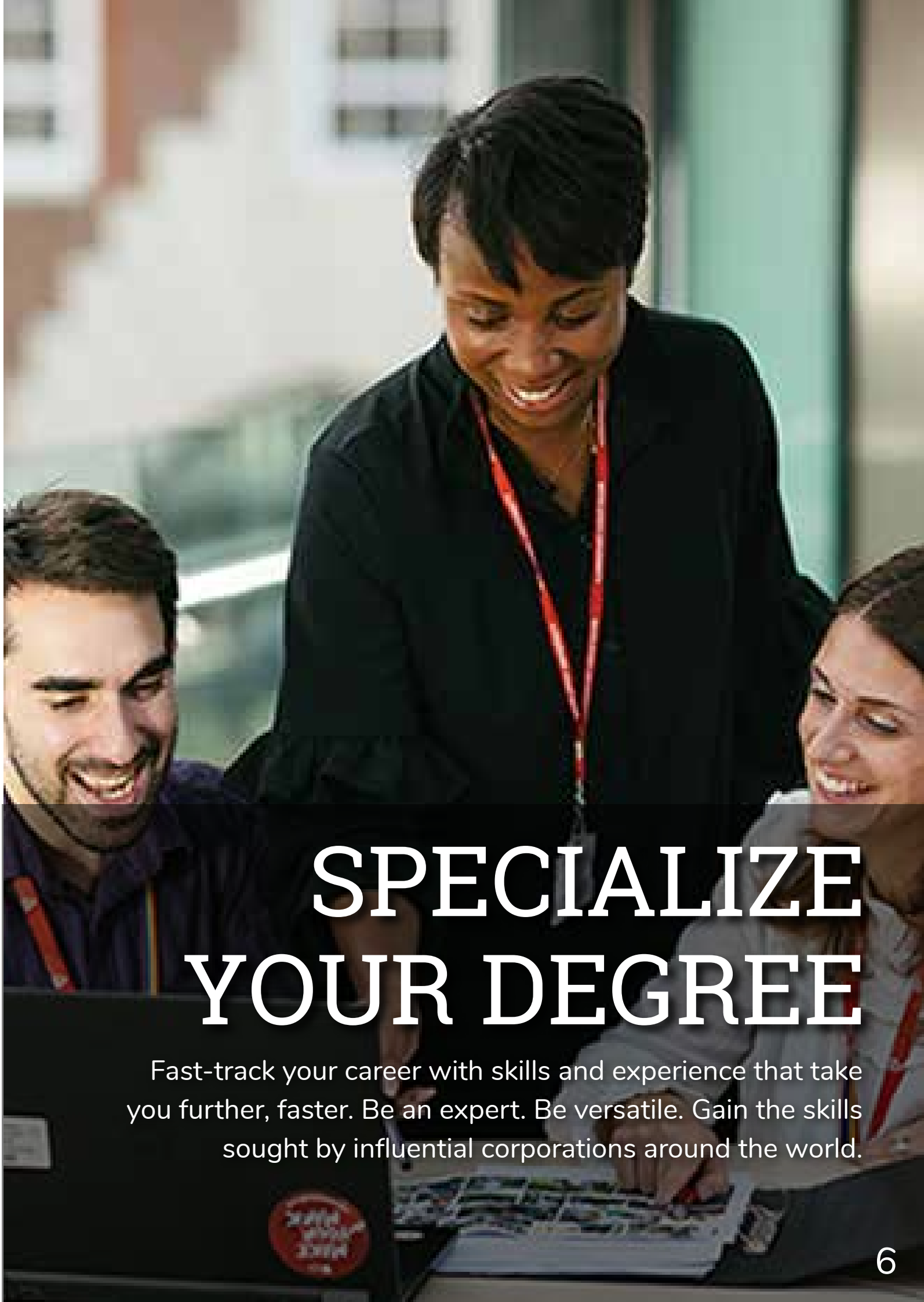
