Introducing curriculum of business school in State University of New York, which combines technology and management



» Three weeks of New York Residence Program in July and August is mandatory in order to receive degrees of State University of New York.





Official English Score

- TOEIC score of 650 or higher or TOEFL iBT score of 85 or higher within 2 years from application date
- English language exemption condition : Applicants may be exempted through submission of supporting documents if one of the following conditions is met.
 - ① Citizens of English-speaking countries ② Holders of degrees in English-speaking countries
- When submitting official English transcripts, submit transcripts received via postal mail instead of online printouts.
